We need to make sure they have proof on insurance and decided on the time allowed for alcohol consumption on the street. Also Pam Karlen asked if would be alright to have inflatables on the lot between Raffertyø and the Municipal Building.
- The Mengenhause family made a donation of \$1,150.00 to be used at the Campground. We have about 700.00 left. Should we pour cement on the last pad? Or do you have any other suggestions?
