

CHAPTER 1-1 CITY COUNCIL

1-1-1 REGULAR MEETINGS

The regular meetings of the City Council of the City of Howard, South Dakota shall be held at the Municipal Building Council Chambers in said city on the first Monday of each month beginning at 7:00 o'clock p.m. except when Monday falls within the first three days of the month, and in that case the meeting shall be held at 7:00 o'clock p.m. on the following Monday. If the Monday falls on a legal holiday, it shall be held on the first Tuesday thereafter.

1-1-2 SPECIAL MEETINGS

Special meetings of the City Council may be called at any time by the Mayor, or by two members of the City Council, to consider such matters as may be mentioned in the call for the meeting.

1-1-3 NOTICE OF SPECIAL MEETINGS

The Finance Officer shall issue written notice for each special meeting stating by what authority The meeting is called, and the time and place of holding such meeting and the matters to be considered. Each member of the City Council shall be served a notice at least three hours before the hour specified for such meeting; provided, however, that if all members of the City Council are present at the roll call for such special meeting, no notice thereof shall be necessary and such notice as herein provided shall be deemed waived.

1-1-4 DUTIES OF MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL

The Mayor and City Council shall have such authority and perform such duties as are prescribed by state statute and city ordinances.

1-1-5 ACTING COUNCIL PRESIDENT

In case the Mayor is unable to perform the duties of his office by reason of absence or sickness, the Council shall appoint by majority vote of all members thereof, one of its Members to act in his stead, whose official title shall be "President of the City Council." The Alderman so appointed shall be invested with all the powers and perform all the duties of Mayor during such sickness or absence.

1-1-6 COUNCIL COMMITTEES

The Mayor may appoint such committees of the members of the City Council as he deems desirable to accomplish an efficient division of the work and duties to be performed by the Council.
