

CHAPTER 7-6 COMMERCIAL TRUCK PARKING

7-6-1 PROHIBIT COMMERCIAL TRUCK PARKING

Whereas, the City Council of the City of Howard deems it to be in the best interest of the health and safety of the citizens of the City of Howard to prohibit commercial truck parking, a truck being defined as any vehicle over 8,000 pounds that is used for any type of commercial enterprise, and anything not self propelled on the streets of the City of Howard.

1. It shall be unlawful to park or leave standing within any residential zone, any commercial truck or trailer on any street for more than a period of two (2) hours at any time within a day.
2. Vehicles left parked or standing in a prohibited area as a result of an emergency stop shall not be in violation of this Ordinance.
3. This Ordinance shall not apply to trucks actively delivering or receiving merchandise from a residence.
4. Any person, firm or corporation violating the provisions of this Ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and punishable by a fine of \$50.00.
